### **PLEASE CHECK YOUR PARCEL**

Please make sure you **PROMPTLY OPEN** and **CHECK THE CONTENTS** of your parcel as soon as you receive it. Our volunteers make every effort to get your order right, but occasionally mistakes are made. If you receive the wrong appliances, we need to know as soon as possible and **definitely within the same month you received the parcel**, otherwise we are unable to make any exchange.

### **SOCIAL MEDIA FOR OSTOMATES**

### **INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS**

You **MUST** be a financial member before any appliances can be issued to you. If you are unable to pay your annual membership fee which is due on 1 July each year, please contact the Secretary for a Time Payment request.

#### **POSTAL ORDERS**

- ALL ORDERS should be addressed to P.O. Box 280, Moonah, 7009.
- Please state your order clearly, quoting the brand name, code no., size and number of appliances you require. Remember to include your name and address.
- Please DON'T ask for "my usual order." Although we have a record of your usual appliances, we don't always know what your usual accessory items are. The best way to ensure you get what you want is to quote the brand and code no.
- Make sure to allow at least two weeks for return delivery, especially when ordering a two-month supply (including holiday orders).
- POSTAGE, PACKAGE AND HANDLING \$12.50 per parcel
- You can pay bulk postage up to 12 months in advance if you wish.
- Please include this payment with your order. Remember to cross all cheques and money orders and make them payable to Ostomy Tasmania. Write your name and address on the back of money orders.
- We have the facility to run a postage account for you if you would like to pay a bulk amount of postage money, thus saving costs of multiple cheques, money orders etc. In this case, you can submit your order by phone, fax, email or online ordering.
- You can make an internet transfer to our bank account (BSB 807 009, Account No. 5109 4661, Name of account: Ostomy Tasmania Inc.)
   Make sure you include your full name as a reference.
- You can phone the office and pay by credit card.

• WHERE:

• Bring a box end (with code number) along so we can see what you require.

### **CERTIFICATES**

**APPLICATION FOR ADDITIONAL STOMA SUPPLIES certificates** (from your Stomal Therapy Nurse or your Doctor) are required for all issues in excess of the maximum monthly allowances.

- Certificates **must** be on Australian Government form PB050, "Application for Additional Stoma Supplies" and be signed by you **and** the STN or Doctor.
- certificates **must** be for a valid medical reason
- they **must** state the number of appliances required
- you will need to contact your STN or GP to renew your certificate every 6 months if the extra product is still required; our office staff can't do it for you.

### PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE

- if you have changed your address;
- if you are the relation of a member who has died;
- if you've had a reversal of your ostomy.
- Don't expect that your Stomal Therapy Nurse will let us know.

# **MEMBERSHIP FEES WERE DUE 1 JULY 2017**

All Australian ostomates are required to pay a uniform fee to be eligible for free appliances from the Stoma Appliance Scheme. This National Access Fee is mandatory and it is not possible for us to waive it, nor to supply appliances to unfinancial members. Members who cannot pay the full fee at once can apply to pay by instalments by completing a Time Payment Request form available from the office. For the 2017/2018 period, our combined fee

is \$60 per year for ordinary members and \$50 per year for concession card holders.

Your fee **MUST** be paid the first time you order appliances after 1 July 2017, or an agreement to pay the fee by instalments must be entered into. Concessional categories include full and part Centrelink pension and Healthcare card holders.

# **GET YOUR ANNUAL REVIEW**

Ostomates are reminded of the importance of getting a review of their stoma by a Stomal Therapy Nurse at least once per year. This ensures that the most appropriate appliances for your circumstance are recommended, especially as there are continually new and improved products added to the Stoma Appliance Scheme throughout the year. It is also useful to have a fresh appraisal from your STN on a regular basis, to gain a better understanding of how you are travelling and what options are available for you when circumstances change.

### PLEASE HELP AVOID WASTE

We would like to remind all ostomates that they have an obligation to only order amounts commensurate to need. Whilst we understand members' anxiety about running out of pouches/wafers and accessories, having too many creates storage & disposal issues (for example many adhesives deteriorate if not stored properly). We therefore recommend that members hold one to two months' supply of their usual products to allow for emergencies or possible stock shortages - but no more than 3 months.

Part of Ostomy Tasmania's responsibility is to ensure a smooth and efficient distribution of product supplied to the membership - your cooperation in helping to reduce waste and associated unnecessary expense to the Government by only ordering what you need helps us to meet that objective and thereby maintains the ongoing integrity of what is a very generous government subsidized scheme.

# **NEW STUDY OPPORTUNITY FOR OSTOMATES**

The following is courtesy of the Centre for Community Driven Research (CCDR): CCDR is a charity working to bring the patient voice to the decision-making table. Our flagship program is a research/advocacy program called Patient Experience, Expectations and Knowledge (PEEK). PEEK studies give us a clear picture and historical record of what it is like to be a patient at a given point in time, and by asking patients about their expectations, PEEK studies give us a way forward to support patients with treatments, information and care. Through this program we give patients the opportunity to talk about their experience and what they would like to see from future treatment, information, care and support. We also ask them what their message to government would be in relation to their condition.

We aim to conduct PEEK studies across a range of disease areas and have secured funding to conduct a program in bladder cancer. This is a study partnership with Ostomy Tasmania, so feel free to contact our office for more information, or via <a href="https://www.cc-dr.org">www.cc-dr.org</a>

# **EATING and DRINKING with a COLOSTOMY**

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION COURTESY STOMATHERAPY.COM**

(This dietary information has been compiled as a Guide only.)

- Because you now have a colostomy you should not have to change your eating habits significantly.
- You may now be able to eat foods you were having trouble with prior to the surgery.
- Each person is an individual and will react to each food type in their own way.
- •It is important that you have a well-balanced diet.

### **REDUCING** gas / wind production

- Eat your food slowly, chew with the mouth closed and avoid gulping your food.
- Eating too much food at one time adds to discomfort.
- Eat regular meals as skipping meals is more likely to increase gas production.

### Foods that may CAUSE gas / wind

Cucumber, peas, beans, orange juice, onions, eggs, cabbage, yeast, mushrooms, baked beans, broccoli, brussel sprouts, corn, garlic, cauliflower, fizzy / carbonated beverages including beer, low calorie sweets and lollies (with Sorbitol).

It may also be as a result of swallowing air. Chewing gum, chewing with your mouth open, drinking with a straw, smoking and snoring can all increase the amount of air you swallow.

### Foods that may PRODUCE odour

Cheese, beans, onions, cabbage, fish, asparagus, broccoli, cauliflower, eggs, lentils, garlic, some spices.

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### Foods that may REDUCE odour

Yoghurt, cranberry juice, yakult, buttermilk, fresh parsley, stewed or grated apple (no skin).

### **Constipation (hard stomal output)**

If constipation should occur, try the following:

- Eat prunes, fresh fruit.
- Aim to drink 2 litres (6 8 glasses) of fluid per day.
- Take a gentle stool softener or fibre supplement.
- If 2-3 days pass with no bowel action, check with your STN or doctor.

### Diarrhoea (runny or fluid stomal output)

Diarrhoea can occur for a variety of reasons. It is recommended that you try to identify the cause of the diarrhoea.

- If diarrhoea occurs, treat as you did before you had a colostomy.
- Consult your doctor if it persists for more than 2 3 days.
- If you usually use a closed pouch you may need to change to a drainable pouch to avoid frequent pouch changes which can affect your skin and the number of supplies available for later use. Speak with your STN.

### Foods to help THICKEN your stomal output

Pasta, pumpkin, dumplings, custard, tapioca, pancakes, pretzels, rice, bananas, toast, mashed potato, apple sauce, arrowroot, marshmallows, uncooked cornflour, cheese, jelly babies, jelly beans, smooth peanut butter, white bread (not fresh), fresh grated apple (no skin)
