### **PLEASE CHECK YOUR PARCEL**

Please make sure you **PROMPTLY OPEN** and **CHECK THE CONTENTS** of your parcel as soon as you receive it. Our volunteers make every effort to get your order right, but occasionally mistakes are made. If you receive the wrong appliances, we need to know as soon as possible and **definitely within the same month you received the parcel**, otherwise we are unable to make any exchange.

### **INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS**

You **MUST** be a financial member before any appliances can be issued to you. If you are unable to pay your annual Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee which is due on 1 July each year, please contact the Secretary for a Time Payment request.

### **POSTAL ORDERS**

- ALL ORDERS should be addressed to P.O. Box 280, Moonah, 7009.
- Please state your order clearly, quoting the brand name, code no., size and number of appliances you require. Remember to include your name and address.
- Please DON'T ask for "my usual order." Although we have a record of your usual appliances, we don't always know what your usual accessory items are. The best way to ensure you get what you want is to quote the brand and code no.
- Make sure to **allow at least two weeks for return delivery**, especially when ordering a two-month supply (including holiday orders).
- POSTAGE, PACKAGE AND HANDLING \$12.50 per parcel
- Please include this payment with your order. Remember to cross all cheques and money orders and make them payable to Ostomy Tasmania. Write your name and address on the back of money orders.
- We have the facility to run a postage account for you if you would like to pay a bulk amount of postage money (up to 12 months), thus saving costs of multiple cheques, money orders etc. In this case, you can submit your order by phone, fax, email or online ordering.
- You can make an internet transfer to our bank account (BSB 807 009, Account No. 5109 4661, Name of account: Ostomy Tasmania Inc.)
   Make sure you include members full name as a reference.
- You can phone the office and pay by credit card.

### **CERTIFICATES**

**APPLICATION FOR ADDITIONAL STOMA SUPPLIES certificates** (from your Stomal Therapy Nurse or your Doctor) are required for all issues in excess of the maximum monthly allowances.

- Certificates **must** be on Australian Government form PB050, "Application for Additional Stoma Supplies" and be signed by you **and** the STN or Doctor.
- certificates **must** be for a valid medical reason
- they **must** state the number of appliances required
- you will need to contact your STN or GP to renew your certificate every 6 months if the extra product is still required; our office staff can't do it for you.

### PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE

- if you have changed your address;
- if you are the relation of a member who has died;
- if you've had a reversal of your ostomy.
- Don't expect that your Stomal Therapy Nurse will let us know.

# **SAS ACCESS FEES WERE DUE 1 JULY 2018**

All Australian ostomates are required to pay a uniform fee to be eligible for free appliances from the Stoma Appliance Scheme. The Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee is mandatory and it is not possible for us to waive it, nor to supply appliances to unfinancial members. Members who cannot pay the full fee at once can apply to pay by instalments by completing a Time Payment Request form available from the office. For the 2018/2019 period, the fee is

Reminder: Please make sure money orders and cheques are made payable to "Ostomy Tasmania Inc." Direct Credit payments must include member's name as reference.

\$60 per year for ordinary members and \$50 per year for concession card holders.

Your fee **MUST** be paid the first time you order appliances after 1 July 2018, or an agreement to pay the fee by instalments must be entered into. Concessional categories include full and part Centrelink pension and Healthcare card holders.

# PRESIDENT'S ANNUAL REPORT

It is my pleasure to present my report for the 2017/18 financial year. Let me begin by thanking our wonderful staff and volunteers for their dedicated service and hard work over the past 12 months. We are very grateful for all that you do to keep things running smoothly, while managing the ever-increasing stock lines, certificates for additional supplies, client expectations for orders, and increased statutory/compliance demands. We reluctantly made the change to eParcel earlier this year when faced with Australia Post's discontinuation of the manual parcel contract. This necessitated some re-organisation of our distribution room to accommodate an additional networked laptop and printer. From all reports this change has proven to be successful, and we are not experiencing the labelling errors of previous years and we are despatching parcels twice a week, which mostly leads to an improved service for our clients. A small percentage of clients have been unhappy with the default requirement for "signature on delivery" after having years of their parcels being left at the front door (or the back door, or behind the pot plant, adjacent to the step, wherever...) but we are managing this with a bit of extra typing from our mailing volunteers. We were also very fortunate to receive a generous bequest from one of our long-term clients. Some of this money has been used to purchase a defibrillator, with the balance added to our building fund. I am sure that the coming year will bring new challenges. I am also confident that we have the staff and volunteers who will be able to meet these challenges, and continue to provide an excellent service for all of our members.

# **CHANGES TO PARCEL WEIGHTS**

Due to changes in parcel postage rates with Australia Post eParcel we are now having to limit our parcel weight to a maximum of 5kg each to meet cost restraints. This means that some orders that previously fitted into one large parcel are now being divided into two parcels, for which postage will have to be paid before we can post. Most circumstances where the 5kg limit is exceeded only affects members who are ordering a two month supply of their product. Thank you for your understanding on this issue.
