COVID-19 THREAT RESPONSE

We would like to assure our members that at the time of writing our main focus is to continue to supply your orders as promptly as possible. However we have had to rearrange our staff/volunteer roster to meet the COVID-19 threat, which means we have no capacity to service phone orders or personal collections at this time.

NB: All major suppliers have advised supply has not been disrupted, however we would advise our members a 3-4 week reserve of your product is wise given the uncertainty going forward.

MAIL DELIVERY ONLY: For those who usually collect their supplies from our office at St John's Park, this is no longer possible. Instead we ask members to arrange parcel delivery (\$15). If you have had your stoma longer than 6 months, you can order a 2 month issue to save on costs. This reduces the risk that the virus can contaminate our work place environment, potentially infecting our staff and volunteers without whom we cannot function. Thank you your understanding and co-operation.

NO PHONE ORDERS: Because we are running small teams of staff/volunteers (to reduce our exposure) we simply don't have the resources to field phone orders at this time. Please email, post, online order or fax instead. For other matters you can still leave a message and we will return your call ASAP.

INCREASE TO MEMBERSHIP FEE

We are introducing a \$10 Association Service Fee in addition to the Stoma Appliance Scheme (SAS) Access Fee. This is necessary primarily because the Federal Government commission we receive on the issue of your appliances has not increased for several years and is therefore not keeping pace with the operating costs for our organisation. The \$10 fee will be added to the usual SAS Access Fee, so for example someone with a concession card will now be asked to pay a total of \$60, non-concessional members \$70, for their 12 month annual membership. This is the first increase in the annual fee since 2014, and whilst we make every attempt to keep costs to a minimum for our membership, the harsh reality is we continue to face increasing costs in the day to day operation of our mostly volunteer run organisation - making it harder to maintain our level of service to you that we would like. **If you are experiencing financial hardship a time payment arrangement can be entered into. PLEASE CHECK YOUR PARCEL

Please make sure you **PROMPTLY OPEN** and **CHECK THE CONTENTS** of your parcel as soon as you receive it. Our volunteers make every effort to get your order right, but occasionally mistakes are made. If you receive the wrong appliances, we need to know as soon as possible and **definitely within the same month you received the parcel**, otherwise we are unable to make any exchange.

ONLINE PAYMENT OPTION COMING SOON

Very soon we are hoping to offer our clients the option to make secure credit card payments for Postage and Membership fees (SAS Access and Association Service fee) via a dedicated portal on the ordering page of our website: www.ostomytas.com.au In an age where making payments via your phone, laptop or tablet is now commonplace, this facility will make it much more convenient for many of you, and negating the necessity to phone in to our office with credit card numbers, etc. each time you make an order. For those of you who would still like to do things the old way, don't worry – we will still offer the usual way to make payments (ie. Cash, Cheque, Money Order). Check the website regularly to see if the payment gateway is up and running.

INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

You **MUST** be a financial member before any appliances can be issued to you. If you are unable to pay your annual Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee + Association Service Fee which is due on 1 July each year, please contact the Secretary for a Time Payment request.

POSTAL ORDERS

- ALL ORDERS should be addressed to P.O. Box 280, Moonah, 7009.
- Please state your order clearly, quoting the brand name, code no., size and number of appliances you require. Remember to include your name and address.
- Please DON'T ask for "my usual order." Although we have a record of your usual appliances, we don't always know what your usual accessory items are. The best way to ensure you get what you want is to quote the brand and code no.
- Make sure to allow at least *THREE* weeks for return delivery, especially when ordering a two-month supply (including holiday orders).
- POSTAGE, PACKAGE AND HANDLING \$15.00 per parcel (extra for large parcels)
- Please include this payment with your order. Remember to cross all cheques and money orders and make them payable to Ostomy Tasmania. Write your name and address on the back of money orders.
- We have the facility to run a postage account for you if you would like to pay a bulk amount of postage money (up to 12 months), thus saving costs of multiple cheques, money orders etc. In this case, you can submit your order by fax, email or online ordering. No Phone Orders during the COVID-19 pandemic please.
- You can make an internet transfer to our bank account

 Make sure you include member's full name as a reference.

CERTIFICATES

APPLICATION FOR ADDITIONAL STOMA SUPPLIES certificates (from your Stomal Therapy Nurse or your Doctor) are required for all issues in excess of the maximum monthly allowances.

- Certificates **must** be on Australian Government form PB050, "Application for Additional Stoma Supplies" and be signed by you **and** the STN or Doctor.
- certificates **must** be for a valid medical reason
- they **must** state the number of appliances required
- you will need to contact your STN or GP to renew your certificate every 6 months if the extra product is still required; our office staff can't do it for you.

PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE

- if you have changed your address;
- if you are the relation of a member who has died;
- if you've had a reversal of your ostomy.
- Don't expect that your Stomal Therapy Nurse will let us know.

ANNUAL FEES ARE DUE 1ST JULY 2020

All Australian ostomates are required to pay a uniform fee to be eligible for free appliances from the Stoma Appliance Scheme. The Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee is mandatory and it is not possible for us to waive it, nor to supply appliances to unfinancial members. This year a \$10 Association Service Fee has been added to assist in maintaining an appropriate level of service to members. Members who cannot pay the full fee at once can apply to pay

Direct Credit payments must include member's name as reference.

by instalments by completing a Time Payment Request form available from the office. For the 2020/2021 period, the total fee is \$70 per year (\$60 SAS Access fee + \$10 Association Service fee) for full members and \$60 per year (\$50 SAS Access fee + \$10 Association Service fee) for concession card holders.

Your fee **MUST** be paid the first time you order appliances after 1 July 2020, or an agreement to pay the fee by instalments must be entered into. Concessional categories include full and part Centrelink pension and Healthcare card holders.
