AS THINGS STAND (COVID)

We are continuing to adapt according to the evolving circumstances caused by the COVID pandemic, and it is a credit to our volunteers / staff /suppliers that since the pandemic first emerged in Australia in March we have been able to continue to meet clients' needs without experiencing too much disruption to service.

It is also worth mentioning that we at Ostomy Tasmania have appreciated the high level of understanding and patience demonstrated by many of our ostomates, especially given the uncertainty created by necessary workplace changes in adapting to the "new normal".

Obviously this pandemic is far from over and we need to be mindful with borders again opening (and until an effective vaccine is found) that we may still need to be ready to react at short notice if/when required. Please be aware that if changes are necessary we will post updated notices prominently on the front page of our website (ostomytas.com.au).

In the meantime, we will continue to open our office for collections to the public on Mondays 9am – 3pm (closed 12-1pm), or by appointment on other normal week days (mornings only). Closed public holidays.

We request that if you can afford the postage please continue with that option, as this helps us deal with orders in a timely manner. One benefit of the changes in our office staffing and procedures is that we are now mailing out with Australia Post most week days, meaning you will (hopefully) receive your order faster.

Email or online order forms are the preferred method for ordering, however phone orders can also be made weekdays 9am – 1pm.

As always it is recommended that you keep 3 weeks supply in reserve at any one time in case of supply difficulties.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR PARCEL

Please make sure you **PROMPTLY OPEN** and **CHECK THE CONTENTS** of your parcel as soon as you receive it. We make every effort to get your order right, but occasionally mistakes are made. If you receive the wrong appliances, we need to know as soon as possible and **definitely within the same month you received the parcel**, otherwise we are unable to make any exchange.

ACSA CONFERENCE CANCELLED

In our last correspondence we reported our intention of hosting the next national conference for the Australian Council of Stoma Associations (ACSA) from October 15 - 18, at the Hotel Grand Chancellor, Hobart. However due to the difficulties that COVID-19 has presented this event was subsequently cancelled. Instead, associations were able to participate in a teleconferencing AGM to be held later in the year. We realise this may be disappointing news for many clients who would have liked to have had the opportunity to attend, however unfortunately circumstances out of our control have intervened. INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

You **MUST** be a financial member before any appliances can be issued to you. If you are unable to pay your annual Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee + Association Service Fee which is due on 1 July each year, please contact the Secretary for a Time Payment request.

POSTAL ORDERS

- ALL ORDERS should be addressed to P.O. Box 280, Moonah, 7009.
- Please state your order clearly, quoting the brand name, code no., size and number of appliances you require. Remember to include your name and address.
- Please DON'T ask for "my usual order." Although we have a record of your usual appliances, we don't always know what your usual accessory items are. The best way to ensure you get what you want is to quote the brand and code no.
- Make sure to allow at least *THREE* weeks for return delivery, especially when ordering a two-month supply (including holiday orders).
- POSTAGE, PACKAGE AND HANDLING \$15.00 per parcel (extra for large parcels)
- Please include this payment with your order. Remember to cross all cheques and money orders and make them payable to Ostomy Tasmania. Write your name and address on the back of money orders.
- We have the facility to run a postage account for you if you would like to pay a bulk amount of postage money (up to 12 months), thus saving costs of multiple cheques, money orders etc. In this case, you can submit your order by fax, email or online ordering. NB: *Phone order availability limited during the COVID-19 pandemic.*

- **CURRENT OPENING HOURS**: **Mondays** (excluding Public Holidays) **9.00 a.m. 12noon** and **1.00 pm 3.00pm.** Other business days strictly **by appointment** only.
- WHERE: St Johns Park, New Town: Amenities Building, which is the second building on your left as you turn in to the St Johns Park complex (Woodhouse Road) from Creek Road. Look for the "Ostomy Tasmania" signs on the building. A few parking spaces are available outside the building (look for the signs).
- Bring a box end (with code number) along so we can see what you require.
- Credit card and EFTPOS facilities are available at the Distribution Centre.

CERTIFICATES

APPLICATION FOR ADDITIONAL STOMA SUPPLIES certificates (from your Stomal Therapy Nurse or your Doctor) are required for all issues in excess of the maximum monthly allowances.

- Certificates must be on Australian Government form PB050, "Application for Additional Stoma Supplies" and be signed by you and the STN or Doctor.
- certificates **must** be for a valid medical reason
- they must state the number of appliances required
- you will need to contact your STN or GP to renew your certificate every 6 months if the extra product is still required; our office staff can't do it for you.

PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE

- if you have changed your address;
- if you are the relation of a member who has died;
- if you've had a reversal of your ostomy.
- Don't expect that your Stomal Therapy Nurse will let us know.

ANNUAL FEES WERE DUE 1ST JULY 2020

All Australian ostomates are required to pay a uniform fee to be eligible for free appliances from the Stoma Appliance Scheme. The Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee is mandatory and it is not possible for us to waive it, nor to supply appliances to unfinancial members. This year a \$10 Association Service Fee has been added to assist in maintaining an appropriate level of service to members. Members who cannot pay the full fee at once can apply to pay

by instalments by completing a Time Payment Request form available from the office. For the 2020/2021 period, the total fee is:

- \$70 per year (\$60 SAS Access fee + \$10 Association Service fee) for full members
- \$60 per year (\$50 SAS Access fee + \$10 Association Service fee) for concession card holders.

Your fee **MUST** be paid the first time you order appliances after 1 July 2020, or an agreement to pay the fee by instalments must be entered into. Concessional categories include full and part Centrelink pension and Healthcare card holders.

NO MORE RAFFLE!

We wish to advise ostomates that the \$50 raffle ticket prize (traditionally drawn at our September AGM and March General Meetings each year) will no longer be run. METHOD TO STERILISE OVERNIGHT BAGS

In response to an ostomate's family member recent query for finding a solution for sterilising and washing out overnight bags, the following advice was offered by Sonia Hicks – Stomal Therapy Nurse at the RHH:

- 1. Household bleach (eg. 6 teaspoons of Miltons solution to 2 cups water)
- 2. White vinegar (1/2 cup to 1 ½ cups of water)

Sonia adds - both solutions will sterilise overnight bags, however vinegar is what patients prefer as bleach can stain clothing and flooring. NB: we (STN's) have <u>never</u> advised soap & water to clean overnight bags.
