INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

You **MUST** be a financial member before any appliances can be issued to you. If you are unable to pay your annual Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee which is due on 1 July each year, please contact the Secretary for a Time Payment request.

POSTAL ORDERS

- ALL ORDERS should be addressed to P.O. Box 280, Moonah, 7009.
- Please state your order clearly, quoting the brand name, code no., size and number of appliances you require. Remember to include your name and address.
- Please DON'T ask for "my usual order." Although we have a record of your usual appliances, we don't always know what your usual accessory items are. The best way to ensure you get what you want is to quote the brand and code no.
- Make sure to allow at least THREE weeks for return delivery, especially when ordering a two-month supply (including holiday orders).
- POSTAGE, PACKAGE AND HANDLING \$15.00 per parcel (extra for parcels over 6kg)
- Please include this payment with your order. Remember to cross all cheques and money orders and make them payable to Ostomy Tasmania. Write your name and address on the back of money orders.
- We have the facility to run a postage account for you if you would like to pay a bulk amount of postage money (up to 12 months), thus saving costs of multiple cheques, money orders etc. In this case, you can submit your order by fax, email or online ordering. NB: *Phone order availability limited*.

COLLECTIONS

- CURRENT OPENING HOURS: Mondays (excluding Public Holidays) 9.00 a.m. 12noon and 1.00 pm 3.00pm. Tuesdays to Fridays 9am 1pm.
- WHERE: St Johns Park, New Town: Amenities Building, which is the second building on your left as you turn in to the St Johns Park complex (Woodhouse Road) from Creek Road. Look for the "Ostomy Tasmania" signs on the building. A few parking spaces are available outside the building (look for the signs).
- Bring a box end (with code number) along so we can see what you require.

CERTIFICATES

APPLICATION FOR ADDITIONAL STOMA SUPPLIES certificates (from your Stomal Therapy Nurse or your Doctor) are required for all issues in excess of the maximum monthly allowances.

- Certificates must be on Australian Government form PB050, "Application for Additional Stoma Supplies" and be signed by you and the STN or Doctor.
- certificates **must** be for a valid medical reason
- they **must** state the total number of appliances required
- you will need to contact your STN or GP to renew your certificate every 6 months if the extra product is still required; our office staff can't do it for you.

PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE

- if you have changed your address;
- if you are the relation of a member who has died;
- if you've had a reversal of your ostomy.
- Don't expect that your Stomal Therapy Nurse will let us know.

ANNUAL FEES WERE DUE 1ST JULY 2022

All Australian ostomates are required to pay the Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee to be eligible for free appliances from the Stoma Appliance Scheme. This fee is mandatory, and it is not possible for us to waive it, nor to supply appliances to unfinancial members. Members who cannot pay the full fee at once can apply to pay by instalments by completing a Time Payment Request form available from the office. For the 2022/2023 period, the fee is:

Reminder: Please make sure money orders and cheques are made payable to "Ostomy Tasmania Inc."
Direct Credit payments must include member's name as reference.

- \$70 per year for full members
- \$60 per year for concession card holders.

Your fee **MUST** be paid the first time you order appliances after 1 July 2022, or an agreement to pay the fee by instalments must be entered into. Concessional categories include full and part Centrelink pension and Healthcare card holders.

TRANSFER OF MEMBERSHIP

PLEASE CHECK YOUR PARCEL

Please make sure you **PROMPTLY OPEN** and **CHECK THE CONTENTS** of your parcel as soon as you receive it. We make every effort to get your order right, but occasionally mistakes are made. If you receive the wrong appliances, we need to know as soon as possible and **definitely within the same month you received the parcel**, otherwise we are unable to make any exchange.

CHRISTMAS CLOSURE DATES

We will close for the Christmas break at 1.00pm on Tuesday 20th December (last day for collections). We will re-open at 9.00 am on Tuesday 3rd January 2023. Requests for December supplies, and double issues for December/January, MUST be with us by 9am Monday 5th December.

STOMA PRODUCTS NO LONGER NEEDED

Whilst we always encourage return of product to the Stoma Therapy departments at your local hospital when the item is no longer needed (eg. a client has had a reversal or sadly passed away), we have recently been contacted by stomal therapy nurses asking that the person responsible please first check the expiry date of the item before bringing to them. Obviously, items beyond their used by date cannot be reissued to other patients in need, and then must be disposed of by the nurses (who have limited storage space). Please note we are unable to take back items here at Ostomy Tasmania if it is beyond the issue month, as we have already been reimbursed by Medicare for the items provided to clients.

IMPORTANT: WEEKLY ORDERING TIMES

Please note we order stock in weekly: Coloplast / Ainscorp / Convatec products early Monday morning, and Dansac / Hollister / Omnigon products early Tuesday morning. If you miss the cut off time your item will not get ordered until the following week (assuming we do not have your product on our shelves). Unfortunately, if we only have one or two users of a particular product, we generally do not keep stock on hand, as we simply do not have enough space, and individual circumstances can change at short notice leaving us with a product we have paid for, but for which we have no users (and therefore cannot claim reimbursement from Medicare).

CONCESSION CARD EXPIRY DATE

We request that all members with concession cards to please check that you have an expiry date that is current, and to provide these details with your next order. We have many needing to update their "valid to" date on our database, and this would assist us in keeping our records up to speed for Medicare purposes. Thank you for your assistance.

REQUEST RE: CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

We would like to remind those members who have internet access that we have a "Payment" page on our website at ostomytas.com.au where credit cards payments (secure gateway with Square) and direct credit banking details can be accessed. Membership, postage, and cash sale items can be made this way at any time — and we are notified of payment immediately when a Square payment is made. By using this facility, you will be helping to reduce our workload in the office and the chance for miscommunication errors which can occur over the phone (which requires us to ring you back to correct). Of course, if you do not have internet access, or do not feel confident with online transactions then you can still ring through your details. We do appreciate your cooperation.

NEW ORDERING PORTAL COMING SOON

ACSA (Australian Council of Stoma Associations) have advised that a new member ordering portal is currently being developed that links in with existing associations' Stoma Appliance Management Systems. This is intended to allow members to login direct to an online ordering portal where individual items and your ordering history can be looked up on a database - and orders submitted direct onto the Australia wide computer management system (SAMS). This may be a more convenient way for ostomates (who are computer savvy) to order their product each month. A couple of associations are currently trialling the new ordering portal. We will keep you posted of developments.

2 MONTH ORDERING EXPLAINED

Just to remind members for those who have had their stoma for longer than 6 months, you can usually order for the current month plus the next month (i.e. a two month supply). The reason for the 6 month waiting period is that members often need to change their products when they are new ostomates.

Please note however that we do reserve the right to restrict 2 month orders to 1 month in certain situations (eg. for Dual Ostomates, or complex orders requiring lots of certificates for extra supplies). Also, we can't issue 2 months of a new product until you have tried it out.
