OSTOMY TASMANIA NEW LOGO & WEBSITE

As you can see on the masthead of this publication Ostomy Tasmania now has a new fresh logo design to replace the old one which was looking a bit dated and badly in need of a rejuvenation.

After many design versions were considered by the management team and volunteers this one was eventually settled on as the most favoured option. Note: the one displayed here is only the black and white version. The colour version will be on the website, and eventually will replace the existing logo on all Ostomy Tasmania correspondence, so keep your eyes peeled over coming months.

Also, by the time this newsletter reaches the printers we will be close to having a new website design for the domain ostomytas.com.au. This is being created by Techbug from Queensland, who have also designed and host websites for Queensland Stoma Association, NSW Stoma Association, Australian Council of Stoma Associations (ACSA), and Australian Association of Stomal Therapy Nurses (AASTN), amongst others.

The new website will be sporting a more modern look, and hopefully be more user friendly to our members. It will eventually include a "members portal" where members will be able to register online to access. Once registered, members will be able to view their own ordering history (including product codes & quantities), place Stoma Appliance Scheme product orders, and make payments (using PayPal), all in one seamless process.

Three of the larger associations have already upgraded to include the portal on their respective websites (eg. Queensland Stoma, Ostomy Assn. of Melbourne and NSW Stoma), and the feedback we are hearing is that, once the user is familiar with the process, it is a much-improved experience for members, as well as reducing administration work for associations. If you visit their websites, you can view instructional videos which show how to use the portal. Watch this space for more news about the portal over coming months!

INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

You **MUST** be a financial member before any appliances can be issued to you. If you are unable to pay your annual Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee which is due on 1 July each year, please contact the Secretary for a Time Payment request.

POSTAL ORDERS

ALL ORDERS should be addressed to P.O. Box 280, Moonah, 7009.

- Please state your order clearly, quoting the brand name, **code no.**, size and **number of appliances** you require. Remember to **include your name and address**.
- Please DON'T ask for "my usual order." Although we have a record of your usual appliances, we don't always know what your usual accessory items are. The best way to ensure you get what you want is to quote the brand and code no.
- Make sure to **allow at least** *THREE* **weeks for return delivery**, especially when ordering a two-month supply (including holiday orders).
- POSTAGE, PACKAGE AND HANDLING \$15.00 per parcel (extra for parcels over 6kg)
- Please include this payment with your order. Remember to cross all cheques and money orders and make them payable to Ostomy Tasmania. Write your name and address on the back of money orders.
- We have the facility to run a postage account for you if you would like to pay a bulk amount of postage money (up to 12 months), thus saving costs of multiple cheques, money orders etc. In this case, you can submit your order by phone, fax, email or online ordering.

- CURRENT OPENING HOURS: Mondays (excluding Public Holidays) 9.00 a.m. 12 noon and
 1.00 pm 3.00 pm. Tuesdays to Fridays 9.00 am 1.00 pm.
- WHERE: St Johns Park, New Town: Amenities Building, which is the second building on your left as you turn in to the St Johns Park complex (Woodhouse Road) from Creek Road. CERTIFICATES

APPLICATION FOR ADDITIONAL STOMA SUPPLIES certificates (from your Stomal Therapy Nurse or your Doctor) are required for all issues in excess of the maximum monthly allowances.

- Certificates must be on Australian Government form PB050, "Application for Additional Stoma Supplies" and be signed by you and the STN or Doctor.
- Certificates **must** be for a valid medical reason
- They **must** state the **total** number of appliances required
- You will need to contact your STN or GP to renew your certificate every 6 months if the extra product is still required; our office staff can't do it for you.
- A once-off Cleanser Wipe Authorisation form signed by your STN or GP is required before we can issue any cleanser wipe products.

PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE

- If you have changed your address;
- If you are the relation of a member who has died;
- If you've had a reversal of your ostomy.
- Don't expect that your Stomal Therapy Nurse will let us know.

ANNUAL FEES DUE 1ST JULY 2024

All Australian ostomates are required to pay the Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee to be eligible for free appliances from the Scheme. This fee is mandatory, and it is not possible for us to waive it, nor to supply appliances to unfinancial members. Members who cannot pay the full fee at once can apply to pay by instalments by completing a Time Payment Request form available from the office. For the 2024/2025 period, the fee will remain at:

Reminder: Please make sure money orders and cheques are made payable to "Ostomy Tasmania Inc." Direct Credit payments must include member's name as reference.

- \$70 per year for full members
- \$60 per year for concession card holders.

Your fee **MUST** be paid the first time you order appliances after 1 July 2024, or an agreement to pay the fee by instalments must be entered into. Concessional categories include full and part Centrelink pension and Healthcare card holders.

If you receive the wrong appliances, we need to know as soon as possible and **definitely within the same month you received the parcel**, otherwise we are unable to make any exchange.

IF YOU RECEIVE A FAULTY PRODUCT

From time to time some of our members have reported receiving faulty products. Examples might be an appliance that has a small leak in the pouch, or wafers that are not adhering properly. When a member encounters any kind of manufacturing fault the best course of action is to contact the company directly (look on the outside of the box the item comes in to determine who the supplier is). You will need to tell them the lot number of the product/s that are faulty (this number is found on the end of the box). If the fault is a genuine manufacturing issue, then the supplier will likely replace them at no cost to you.

NATIONAL STOMAL THERAPY AWARENESS WEEK




