



INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

You **MUST** be a financial member before any appliances can be issued to you. If you are unable to pay your annual Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee which is due on 1 July each year, please contact the Secretary for a Time Payment request.

POSTAL ORDERS

ALL ORDERS should be addressed to P.O. Box 280, Moonah, 7009.

- Please state your order clearly, quoting the brand name, code no., size and number of appliances you require. Remember to include your name and address.
- Please DON'T ask for "my usual order." Although we have a record of your usual appliances, we don't always know what your usual accessory items are. The best way to ensure you get what you want is to quote the brand and code no.
- Make sure to **allow at least TWO weeks for return delivery**, especially when ordering a two-month supply (including holiday orders).
- POSTAGE, PACKAGE AND HANDLING \$15.00 per parcel (extra for parcels over 6kg)
- Please include this payment with your order. Remember to cross all cheques and money orders and make them payable to Ostomy Tasmania. Write your name and address on the back of money orders.
- We have the facility to run a postage account for you if you would like to pay a bulk amount of postage money (up to 12 months), thus saving costs of multiple cheques, money orders etc. In this case, you can submit your order by phone, fax, email or online ordering.

COLLECTIONS

- CURRENT OPENING HOURS: Mondays (excluding Public Holidays) 9.00 a.m. 12 noon and 1.00 pm 3.00 pm. Tuesdays to Fridays 9.00 am 1.00 pm.
- WHERE: St Johns Park, New Town: Amenities Building, which is the second building on your left as you turn in to the St Johns Park complex (Woodhouse Road) from Creek Road. Look for the "Ostomy Tasmania" signs on the building. A few parking spaces are available outside the building (look for the signs).
- Bring a box end (with code number) along so we can see what you require.
- **Credit card** and EFTPOS facilities are available at the Distribution Centre.

CERTIFICATES

APPLICATION FOR ADDITIONAL STOMA SUPPLIES certificates (from your Stomal Therapy Nurse or your Doctor) are required for all issues in excess of the maximum monthly allowances.

- Certificates must be on Australian Government form, "Application for Additional Stoma Supplies -Clinical" and be signed by you and the STN or Doctor.
- Certificates must be for a valid medical reason
- They **must** state the **total** number of appliances required
- You will need to contact your STN or GP to renew your certificate every 6 months if the extra product is still required; our office staff can't do it for you.
- A once-off Cleanser Wipe Authorisation form signed by your STN or GP is required before we can issue any cleanser wipe products.

PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE

- If you have changed your address;
- If you are the relation of a member who has died;
- If you've had a reversal of your ostomy.
- Don't expect that your Stomal Therapy Nurse will let us know.

ANNUAL FEES ARE DUE 1ST JULY 2025

All Australian ostomates are required to pay the Stoma Appliance Scheme Access Fee to be eligible for free appliances from the Scheme. This fee is mandatory, and it is not possible for us to waive it, nor to supply appliances to unfinancial members. Members who cannot pay the full fee at once can apply to pay by instalments by completing a Time Payment Request form available from the office. For the **2025/2026** period, the fee will increase to

Reminder: Please make sure money orders and cheques are made payable to "Ostomy Tasmania Inc." Direct Credit payments must include member's name as reference.

- \$85 per year for full members
- \$75 per year for concession card holders.

Your fee **MUST** be paid the first time you order appliances after 1 July 2025, or an agreement to pay the fee by instalments must be entered into. Concessional categories include full and part Centrelink pension and Healthcare card holders.

NB: Any new members joining in April & May 2025 will pay the current rate of \$70 ordinary, \$60 concession. Members joining in June are made financial for the 2025/26 year.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR PARCEL

Please make sure you **PROMPTLY OPEN** and **CHECK THE CONTENTS** of your parcel as soon as you receive it. We make every effort to get your order right, but occasionally mistakes are made. If you receive the wrong appliances, we need to know as soon as possible and **definitely within the same month you received the parcel**, otherwise we are unable to make any exchange.

SUPPLIER ORDERING DAYS

Just a reminder to our members that our normal weekly supplier ordering days from are **Monday** morning (Coloplast, Convatec, Ainscorp) and **Tuesday** morning (Dansac, Hollister, Braun, Omnigon) – **before 10am**. If you miss this cutoff your product will not get ordered until the following Monday or Tuesday, hence potentially delaying the arrival of your order for another week.

CHECK YOUR CUPBOARD REGULARLY

We are still getting quite a lot of orders where members are leaving it until the last minute to order their appliances. We recommend you have at least 3 -4 weeks' worth of appliances stored in your cupboard. We occasionally get messages like "I'm desperate, I've run out of pouches/baseplates – can you help me please". This can create a lot of headaches for our staff because we then need to scramble to find an alternative to get the member out of trouble - until we receive their product in from the supplier (up to 2 weeks). It also often puts an added burden on the hard-working Stomal Therapy Nurses who are also put on the spot to try and help at short notice. We therefore request you regularly check on the status of your supplies to ensure you have enough to see you through until the next order. If you find you are running low at the end of each monthly cycle when ordering the maximum supply allowed, the best course of action is to contact your STN to see if they can give you a certificate for additional supplies (script) to help you get ahead (or maybe have your system reviewed). Better that than running low each time you are due to order.

SOME CLEANSER WIPES TO BE DISCONTINUED

We wish to inform our members that Dansac Cleanser wipes – product code **710000-000** or **71000-0010** are being discontinued from the Stoma Appliance Scheme (SAS) as of 1st April 2025 Coloplast Cleanser wipes however, will still be available – these are Comfeel cleanser wipes – product code **4715** for individually wrapped wipes (box of 30, 2 boxes per month) or Brava Skin Cleanser wipes – product code **12080** (travel pack of 15 wipes, 4 packs per month). Remember that you do require a Cleanser Wipe Authorisation for your initial issue of these products.

MEMBERSHIP FEES TO INCREASE 25/26

Just a reminder to our members that due to increasing costs and overheads associated with running a Not for Profit organisation we are now having to increase our yearly subscription. Consequently, fees for the 25/26 financial year will increase for **Full Members** to **\$85** and **Concession** Members **\$75**, and Associate Members \$25. NB: This is the first SAS fee increase we have implemented since 2019/20.

SUPPORT GARMENT ALLOWANCE

At the start of each calendar year you are entitled to order 4 support belts if required. In the first instance you should only order one belt to check for fit and comfort, and then you can order the remaining amount as required. It's best to choose your belt with the assistance of your stomal therapy nurse however if this is not possible, you can also check out the company websites to see which size and style best suits your body, as well as the necessary code numbers to place an order with us. The belts are particularly helpful if you have a hernia. NB: pants and briefs are no longer available on the scheme, but can be purchased direct from the suppliers.
